Cerberus

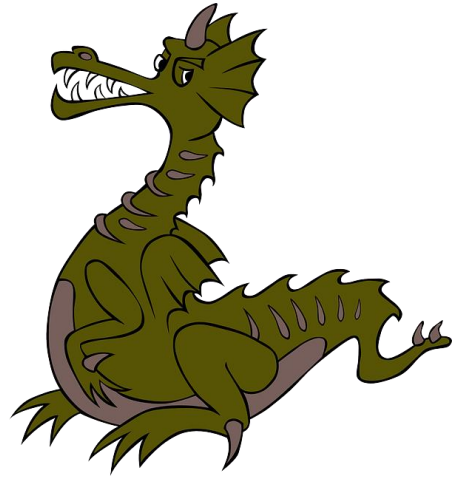
The three-headed dog
