A JACKIWA POEM - juh-key-waa

- ❖ A jackiwa Poem is a Judi Billcliff idea.
- ❖ It is structured like a (sideways) triangle where poets tell their story in a minimalistic way.
- ❖ A jackiwa poem tells a simple but complete story in 8 lines:

- 1 word: topic**
- 2 words: use adjectives/describing words**
- 3 words: uses verbs**
- 4 words: story builds up**
- 4 words: start to work for a conclusion**
- 3 words: use verbs**
- 2 words: use adjectives**
- 1 word: ties back to topic**
